Members of the Board of School Trustees of the Brownstown Central Community School Corporation met on Tuesday, June 28, 2022 at 6:00 p.m. at Brownstown Central Administration Office, 608 West Commerce Street, Brownstown, IN 47220 to discuss representation on the school board of trustees.

President Scott Shade called the meeting to order. Paul Borden led the Pledge of Allegiance, and a moment of silence was observed.

Roll call was taken by President Scott Shade. Members David Martin, Mary Lou Burcham, and Paul Borden were present, as were Superintendent Tim Taylor, Assistant Superintendent Jade Peters, Melissa Hogan, Paula Workman, Jerry Hounshel, 2 patrons, and 1 member of the media. Member Clayton Beard arrived at a later time. Members Gina Hackman and Brian Wheeler were absent.

Scott Shade briefly discussed the previous work sessions for any patrons that were not present on May 2, 2022 and May 31, 2022.

Scott Shade discussed the current option for board representation that all board members would like to proceed with. This option will allow every seat to serve 4 consecutive terms with a 2 to 3 year break every 16 years.

BCCSC board of trustees' believe that this option is the best option for the students and community of Brownstown school district.

Doug Nuss and Mary Ann Spray thanked the board for the time and effort that they have put towards future board representation for BCCSC.

Scott Shade stated that this option will allow BCCSC to remain unified, and continue the process of working together.

Clayton Beard stated that this option is good for all townships, especially the smaller townships. It allows them to stay involved and be able to participate in future decisions of the students and community within BCCSC.

Having no other business, on a motion by David Martin, seconded by Clayton Beard, the board unanimously approved to adjourn the meeting at 6:35 p.m.
